#### **RISK**

- 1 Extremely likely to occur
- 2 Possibly could occur
- 3 Slight chance of occurring

## **RISK ASSESSMENT CRITERIA\***

(\*To be used in conjunction with Risk Rating flow chart)

### 1. Has the person ever displayed any violent, aggressive or intimidating behaviour?

- 1. **A** Physical assault including the use of weapon such as knives, guns or other dangerous objects
- 2. A Known convictions for
  - 1) Murder
  - 2) Manslaughter
  - 3) GBH
  - 4) Identified Schedule One Offender
- 3. **B** Threatening behaviour
- 4. **B** Verbal aggression
- 5. **B** History of violence (physical or verbal) against:
  - 1) Ethnic groups
  - 2) Men or women
  - 3) Gay/lesbians
  - 4) Other identified group

# 2. Does the person display any behaviour that could present a risk or be of concern to others?

- **A** Known to have followed workers/other professionals/ become obsessive with previous workers
- **A** Known to have misinterpreted information or made unfounded allegations against staff
- **B** Intimidating behaviour
- **B** Taking pictures with mobile phones
- **B** Clocking car number plates
- **B** Client locking entry/escape doors once staff enter property
- ullet **B** Theft or damage to car or property
- **B** Loss of personal possessions e.g. diary/mobile phone in clients property
- ullet **B** Known history of domestic violence
- ullet **B** Neglect of home to point of health hazard/handling dirty/contaminated mail
- **B** Passive smoking

- 3. Does the person have any "triggers" which may influence their behaviour?
  - **B** Known to respond adversely to certain triggers
- 4. Does the person have a history of alcohol abuse?
  - **A/B** Alcohol misuse
- 5. Does the person have a history of illegal or prescription drug misuse?
  - **A** Amphetamine (powder or pill)
  - **A** Amphetamine (injected)
  - **A** Crack/cocaine
  - $\mathbf{A}$  Cocaine
  - $\mathbf{A}$  Unscripted
  - **A** Heroin (injected)
  - **B** Heroin (smoked)
  - **B** Opiates
  - **B** Methadone
  - ullet **B** Other misuse of prescription drugs
  - $\mathbf{B}$  Cannabis
  - $\mathbf{B}$  Scripted

# 6. Is the person at risk from illness (including mental health problems) and or disability?

Note – Not appropriate to allocate risk rating unless one of the following apply

- **B** Schizophrenia
- $\mathbf{B}$  Personality Disorder
- ullet B Obsessive Compulsive Disorder
- $\mathbf{B}$  HIV/AIDS
- $\mathbf{B}$  Hepatitis C
- ullet **B** Non compliance with/erratic use of prescribed medication (leading to deterioration in mental health)
- **C** Depression and/or anxiety

### 7. Is the person at risk from self neglect, self harm or suicide?

- $\mathbf{B}$  Self harming
- $\mathbf{B}$  Suicide attempts
- $\mathbf{B}$  Risks to themselves
- $\mathbf{B}$  Exposure to blood borne viruses
- ullet **B** Neglect of home to point of health hazard/handling dirty/contaminated mail

### 8. Is the person vulnerable to exploitation by others?

- $\mathbf{C}$  Partners
- $\mathbf{C}$  Relatives
- **C** Cold Callers
- C Drug Suppliers
- **C** Financial exploitation

### 9. Are there any other risks from associates, relatives or pets?

- A Known associates who may present a risk
- $\mathbf{B}$  Use of dogs/other pets to intimidate/threaten

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
